

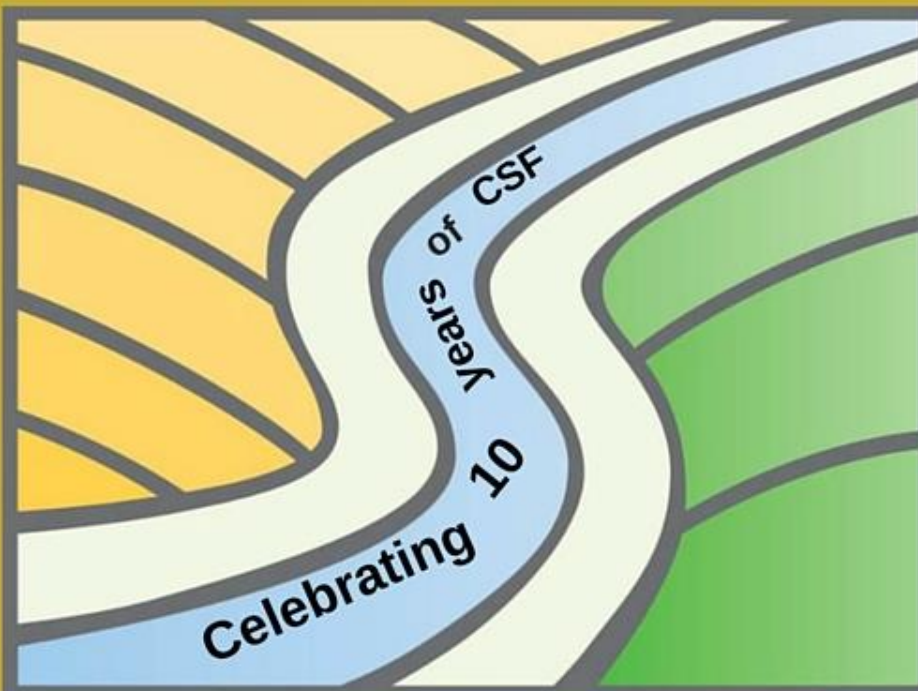
Advice delivered to 19,300 farmers and land managers across England
