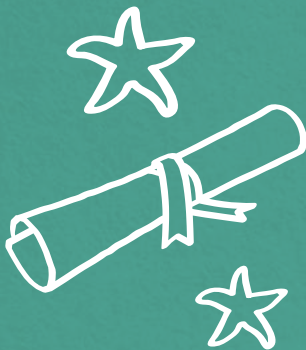


# School checklist activity

## You can make a difference to cleaner seas by becoming a LOVEmyBEACH school.

Here is a list of ways your school can help improve water quality and reduce plastic pollution.

How many boxes can you tick?

Split into 4 groups and complete a section per group.

### In the toilets:

- There are posters or stickers in the toilet asking pupils to only flush the 3 Ps: pee, poo and paper. Design your own poster or download a free one from our website.

- There is a bin in the toilets to encourage pupils to put rubbish in it instead of flushing down the toilet.

---

- Your toilets are dual flush, low-water use or have a cistern block to reduce water use. A cistern block is something that reduces the volume of water in the cistern - it can be as simple as half a brick in the cistern!

---

- Your taps and showers (if you have them) are fitted with water saving devices or have water saving features such as automatic shut-off or flow restrictors.





### In the school kitchen:

- You have checked with the kitchen team that fats, oils and grease are not poured down the sink in the kitchen. Instead they are collected by a licensed contractor or thrown in the bin once cooled.
- You have checked with the kitchen team that greasy pans are wiped with kitchen roll before being washed up.
- You have asked the kitchen team to display a 'what not to pour poster' in the kitchen. Design your own poster or download a free one from our website.

### Elsewhere in school:

- You have marked your surface water drains with the Yellow Fish logo; highlighting that these drains run directly to rivers & seas. Get assistance from grounds maintenance to check your site maps. Download a guidance pack from our website.
- You have something in place to reduce or collect the water that lands on the school roof such as water butts, recycling rainwater to flush the toilets or a green roof.
- You have access to free tap water refills, discouraging single use bottled water.



### Spread the word:



- You have written a story or drawn a picture explaining how you've helped LOVEmyBEACH.
- You have displayed your posters around school to help highlight how other pupils can help care for the beach.
- Everyone in the class has a pledge card to take home to complete with their family & friends.
- Your school supports LOVEmyBEACH on social media and has a link to LOVEmyBEACH.org on their website.
- You have reduced litter by conducting a litter pick in your local environment or at the beach.
